CONSULT AGAINST THE CHRIST

Ps 2:1-12 . "Why do the heathen rage, and the people **imagine a Vain thing?** The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers **take counsel** together, **Against the LORD, and against His Anointed (Christ),** saying, Let us break (Tear Away) their (Christian Doctrine) bands asunder, and cast away their cords (concepts) from (influencing) us. He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the LORD shall have them in derision. Then shall He speak unto them in His Wrath, and vex them in His sore displeasure.



Yet have I set MY King upon MY Holy hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto Me, Thou art MY Son; this day have I begotten Thee. **Ask of ME, and I shall give Thee the heathen for Thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for Thy possession.** Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; Thou shalt dash them in pieces like a Potter's vessel. Fear, and Rejoice with Trembling. Kiss (Revere) the Son, lest He be angry, and ye perish from the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put Their Trust in Him." (KJV)



"BEHOLD THE MAN!"

As Jesus Christ stood before Roman Governor Pontius Pilate on his pavement of Judgment, he realized how powerless he was to turn back the 'staged opposition' Against Him. John 19:4-9 "Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring Him forth to you, that ye may know that **I find no**

fault in Him. Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And Pilate saith unto them, **Behold The Man!** When the chief priests therefore and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye Him, and crucify Him: **for I find**

no fault in Him. The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law He ought to die, because He made himself the **Son of GOD.** When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid; And went again into the judgment hall, and saith unto **Jesus, Whence art Thou?** But **Jesus** gave him no answer." -KJV

THE TRUE AND RIGHTFUL HEIR

Do the World rulers know that "Christ is the Heir"? Yes! Without a doubt, for the Rulers knew in the Day of His first Arrival, and Feared His Sovereignty. JESUS TELLS THIS PARABLE ABOUT HIS FATHER: Mt 21:37-41 (WNT). **"Later still HE SENT to them HIS SON, saying, 'They Will Respect MY SON!'"** "But the vine-dressers, when they saw The Son, said to one another, **"Here is The Heir: come, let us kill Him and get His Inheritance."** "So they seized Him, dragged Him out of the vineyard, and killed Him. When then The

Owner of the vineyard Comes, what will He do to those vine-dressers?" "He will put the wretches to a wretched death," was the reply, "and will Entrust the Vineyard to **other vine-dressers who will Render The Produce to Him at the Vintage Season."** —JESUS



THE MARRIAGE PLANNED FOR THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON

While JESUS never took a wife in His earthly life, He was 'Coined' by John the Baptist as "THE BRIDEGROOM" In view of His Coming Kingdom when He would Reign as King with His Queen and Bride on her throne at his side. Mt 22:2 **"The Kingdom of the Heavens,"** He said, **"may be compared to A KING who Celebrated the Marriage of His Son,** and sent His servants to call the



invited guests to the wedding, but they were unwilling to come. "Again He sent other servants with a message to those who were invited. "My

breakfast is now ready," he said, `my bullocks and fat cattle are killed, and every preparation is made: **come to the wedding.**' "They however gave no heed, but went, one to his home in the country, another to his business; and the rest seized the King's servants, maltreated them, and murdered them. So the King's anger was stirred, and He sent His troops and destroyed those murderers and burnt their City." —JESUS.

THE VALUE OF A KING

Who Values a King who comes as a Servant? And what kind of a 'Heavenly King' would leave behind His Glory to become 'human' so He could give Himself in Sacrifice for ungodly and unthankful men?

Mt 23:37-39 WNT **"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem! thou who murderest the Prophets and stonest those who have been sent to thee! how often have I Desired to Gather thy Children To Me, just as a hen gathers her chickens**

under her wings, and you would not come! See, your House will now be left to you Desolate (No Temple or High Priest)! For I tell you that you will never see Me again until you say, <`Blessed be He who comes in the Name of The LORD.'> —JESUS.

THE VALUE OF A MAN

Can Silver or Gold in Abundance ever measure the VALUE OF ONE MAN or Child?

Yet men, for spite, have been betrayed and sold for a little value and a little gain: (Gen 37:28)

JOSEPH was sold for 20 pieces of Silver into Slavery by his own brothers. But Silver tried them later on! (Gen 44:2). When men value Silver and Gold over the Precious 'Soul' Life of others, it becomes Dross! Both the Righteous and the poor are often sold for Silver. (Amos 2:6, 8:4-7). But neither Silver or Gold will save the un-righteous

betrayers. Zechariah 11:12 "And I (Judas) said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price **thirty pieces of silver**. And the LORD said unto me, **Cast it unto the Potter: a goodly price that I Was Prized At of them.** And I (Judas) took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to **the potter** in the house (Temple) of the LORD." (OT-NT)

Mt 26:14-16 "Then one of the twelve, called **Judas Iscariot**, went unto the chief priests, And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver Him unto you? And they covenanted with him **for thirty pieces of silver**. And from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him."

Mt 27:3-9 Then Judas, which had

betrayed Him, when he saw that He was condemned, repented himself, and **brought again the thirty pieces of silver** to the chief priests and elders, Saying, **I have sinned in that I have betrayed The Innocent Blood.** And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that. **And he cast down the pieces of silver in the Temple, and departed**, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests **took the silver pieces**, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is **the price of blood**. **And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.** Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the **thirty pieces of silver, the price of Him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;**" —(KJV)

DO NO HARM TO THAT INNOCENT MAN

Matt 27:19 "When he (Pilate) was set down on the judgment seat, **his wife sent unto him, saying, Have thou nothing to do with that Just Man:** for I have

suffered many things this day in a dream because of Him."



A WOMAN WHO VALUED "THE MAN"

Mt 26:6-13 "Now when **Jesus** was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper, **There came unto Him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on His head, as He sat at**

meat. But when His disciples saw it, they had indignation, saying, To what purpose is this **waste?** For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor. When

Jesus understood it, He said unto them, Why trouble ye the woman? **for she hath wrought a good work upon Me.** For ye have the poor always with you; but Me ye have not always. For in that she hath poured this ointment on My body, she **did it for My Burial.** Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever This Gospel shall be Preached in the Whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be **told for a Memorial Of Her.**" (KJV)

PETER, THE FISHERMAN/DISCIPLE/APOSTLE AND SERVING SHEPHERD, CALLED TO FEED CHRIST'S SHEEP AND LAMBS, WAS CALLED BECAUSE HE HAD RECEIVED REVELATION FROM GOD, CONCERNING JESUS AND HIS MISSION. LET'S LISTEN IN ON A CONVERSATION BETWEEN PETER AND JESUS. Mt 16:13-15 When He arrived in the neighborhood of Caesarea Philippi, Jesus questioned His disciples. **"Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"** He asked. **Some say John the Baptist,"** they replied; **"others Elijah; others Jeremiah or one of the Prophets."** **"But you, who do you say that I am?"** He asked again. Mt 16:16-19 **"You," replied Simon Peter, "are the Christ, the Son of The Ever-Living GOD."** "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-jonah," said Jesus; **"for mere human nature has not revealed this to you, but my Father in Heaven.** And I declare to you that you are Peter, and that upon this Rock (OF REVELATION) **I will build My Church, and the might of Hades shall not triumph over it.** I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of the Heavens; and whatever you bind on earth shall remain bound in Heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall remain loosed in Heaven." Mt 16:20-21 **Then He urged His disciples to tell no one that He was the Christ.** From this time Jesus began to explain to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer much cruelty from the Elders and the High Priests and the Scribes, and be put to death, **and on the Third day be Raised to Life Again.**" —JESUS (WNT).

EVEN THE GREAT KING/FATHER/LORD GOD, VALUES HIS BELOVED SON:

Ps 110:1-7 KJV. "A Psalm of (King) David. **"The LORD (the Existing One) said unto my Lord (Master), Sit (Remain) Thou at MY Right Hand, until I Make Thine enemies Thy Footstool.** The LORD shall send (Extend) the rod of Thy strength out of Zion: Rule Thou in the midst of Thine enemies. Thy people (Israel) shall be willing in the day of Thy

power, in the beauties of holiness (set apartness) from the Womb (matrix) of the (dawn) Morning: Thou hast the dew (Vigor) of Thy youth. The LORD hath



sworn, and will not repent (be sorry), **Thou art A Priest For ever after the order of Melchizedek (Priest/King Order).**

The Lord at THY right hand shall strike (Pierce, wound severely) through kings in the day of His (anger) wrath. He shall judge (requite, vindicate) among the heathen, He shall fill the places with the dead bodies; He shall wound (strike through) the heads (summits) over many countries (throughout the earth).
