## THE SECRET GROWTH OF SEEDS AND TARES.

**Mark 4:26** “**And HE Said, So Is The Kingdom Of GOD, As if a man should cast Seed into the ground;**

(cast seed into: epi, ep-ee' = over, upon, at, on, of direction. Sometimes we just cast the **Gospel Seed (Word)** on the ground. Even if it doesn't get into it, or into the life of the person, it's there, if their **Soil** can take it in, and let it **Germinate**). Let's look at...

**Isaiah 55:11** “**So Shall MY Word be that Goeth forth out of MY Mouth: it shall Not return to ME Void, but it shall Accomplish that which I Please, and it shall Prosper in the Thing whereto I Send it.**

(Both **GOD** And His **Son** Spoke, And It Happened. We Need To Believe When We Share The **Gospel**, that the **Word** will fall on Good ground, and it will Produce **Faith** in those who can hear it. And even if we

don't see an immediate response, if the Seed gets into their ears, it can begin to germinate).

**Mark 4:27** “**And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the Seed Should Spring and Grow Up, and he knoweth not how.** (**Spring**: blas-tan'-o = Germinate, Sprout. **And grow up**: may-koō'-no = to lengthen, enlarge. We Can Share the **Gospel** with people, and all of a sudden, they start **Believing** and we're surprised, because we thought they were not listening).

**4:28** “**For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.** (**eth** ending on certain Hebrew and Greek Verbs designates **On-Going Action**. **Earth**: ge =

**Soil, Earth and it's Occupants, ground, land, world.** **Bringeth forth fruit**: karpophoreo, kar-pof-or-eh'-o = to be Fertile, Fruitful. **Of herself**: automatos, ow-tom'-at-os = of own accord.

**Isaiah 55:10-11** “**For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and Maketh It Bring Forth And Bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: So Shall MY Word be that Goeth forth out of MY Mouth: it shall Not return to ME Void, but it shall Accomplish that which I Please, and it shall Prosper in the Thing whereto I Send it.** (Even when we Share the **Gospel**, Let us Quote the **Words Of GOD, The Words Of JESUS**).

**4:29 “But when the Fruit is brought forth, immediately He putteth in the Sickle, because the Harvest is Come.**

**(But when the Fruit:** kar-pos' = fruit to pluck. From harpazo, har-pad'-zo = to pull, seize, catch up away, take. **is brought forth:** par-ad-id'-o-mee = to give along, or over, surrender, yield up, transmit. **Immediately he putteth in:** apostello, ap-os-tel'-lo = to send forth, or away. **The Sickle:** drep'-an-on = a gathering hook for plucking, Harvesting. This Greek word, **drepanon** is only mentioned here and several times in **The Revelation Of JESUS CHRIST.**

**Rev 14:14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19. The Last Days Harvest. Because the Harvest:** ther-is-mos' = The Reaping of The Crop. **Is Come:** par-is'-tay-mee = To Stand Beside, To Exhibit).

#### THE PARABLE OF THE TARES:

**Matthew 13:24 “Another Parable Put HE Forth to them, Saying, The Kingdom Of Heaven is likened unto a Man which Sowed Good Seed In His Field:** (The Kingdom: bas-il-i'-ah = Royal Rule, Realm. **Of Heaven is likened:** Compared, be Similar, Resemble. **Unto a Man:** Anthropos, anth'-ro

-pos = man-faced, human being, certain **Man.** **Which Sowed:** spi'-ro = Extending, to scatter. **Good:** kal-os' = Beautiful (Moral, Valuable, Virtuous, for Appearance and Use). **Seed:** For Planting. **In His (Own) Field:** agros, ag-ros' = Country, Land (Israel).

**13:25 “But while men Slept, HIS Enemy Came and Sowed Tares among the Wheat, and went his way.** (**Slept:** kath-yoo'-do = to lie down to rest. **HIS Enemy:** echthros, ekh-thros' = Hateful, Opponent. (See Matthew 22:44). **came and sowed Tares:** zizannion, dziz-an'-ee-on = False grain, darnel. A grain that looks like **Wheat** while growing, but when full grown, is poisonous. (it is common in the East for Enemies of **Christ**, to sow false religions, and those false religions have spread all over the world. These weeds once sown, are difficult to get rid of, and they Persecute Christians).

**13:26 “But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then Appeared the Tares also.** (**brought forth fruit:** false religions produce bad fruit in it's populations. **appeared:** to be seen, show. **The Tares also:** zizanion = false grain, poisonous darnel. False religions show themselves in their Assault Against Christians).

**13:27 “So the servants of the Householder came and said unto Him, Sir, didst not Thou Sow Good Seed In Thy Field? From whence then hath it Tares?** (**Householder:** oikodespotes, oy-kod-es-pot'-ace = the head of the family. **Sir:** kyrios, koo'-ree-os = **Lord, Supreme In Authority, Master, God.**)

**13:28 “HE Said unto them, An Enemy hath done this. The servants said unto Him, wilt Thou then that we go and Gather them up?** (**HE Said:** phemi, fay-mee' = to make known one's thoughts. **An Enemy:** echthros = a hateful active hostile (Satan). **Gather:** syllego, sool-leg'-o = to Collect together, up).

**13:29-30 “But HE Said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the Tares, ye Root Up also the Wheat with them. Let both grow together until The Harvest: and in the Time Of Harvest I Will Say To The Reapers, Gather Ye Together First The Tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: But Gather The Wheat Into MY Barn.** (**Gather:** synago, soon-ag'-o = to lead together. Collect, convene, specially to entertain hospitably together. Assemble Resort, Take Up, In. **into MY Barn:** apothekē, ap-othay'-kay = a repository, granary).

**13:37-39 “HE Answered And Said Unto Them, HE That Soweth The Good Seed Is The Son Of Man; The Field Is The World; The Good Seed Are The Children Of The Kingdom; But The Tares Are The Children Of The Wicked One; The Enemy That Sowed Them Is The Devil; The Harvest Is The End Of The World; And The Reapers Are The Angels.** (Devil: diabolos, dee-ab'-ol-os = traducer, false accuser, slanderer). **World:** aion ahee-ohn' End of this **Age**, at **JESUS Christ's Second Coming** to begin The Millennium; **His 1,000 Year Reign From Jerusalem, Israel.**
